



**SLIA PROFESSIONAL
PRACTICE EXAMINATIONS PART III
2012 AND 2013**

Prospective candidates who intend to sit the above Examinations in the years **2012 and 2013** are invited to register with the Sri Lanka Institute of Architects (SLIA) before **29th February 2012** for Practical Training Counseling.

Eligibility requirements

Prospective candidates must have the potential to acquire the following eligibility requirements by 15th December of 2012 and 2013 respectively to sit for the Part III -2012 and Part III 2013 examinations.

i. Candidates who have successfully completed the SLIA Professional Practice Examinations Part I & II, and possess 52 weeks of Practical Training work experience under a Corporate Member of the SLIA after SLIA Part II Examination.

Or

ii. Candidates who have successfully completed the B.Sc. (Built Environment) degree or equivalent and M.Sc. (Architecture) degree or equivalent and possess 52 weeks of full-time Practical Training work experience after completing the B.Sc. (Built Environment) degree or equivalent and another 52 weeks of full time practical training experience after completing M.Sc. (Architecture) degree or equivalent under a Corporate Member of the SLIA in both cases.

Or

iii. Candidates who have completed the B.Arch. Degree (5year Programme) or equivalent and possess 104 weeks of full time practical training experience after completing the B.Arch./Degree.

Applications for Registration may be obtained from the Board of Architectural Education office at the SLIA Secretariat on payment of Application and processing fee of Rs. 900.00 + Govt. taxes, during normal working hours from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. (Monday to Friday).

Those who have already applied to sit for Part III -2012 need not reapply.

Duly perfected applications should be handed over to the Secretary, BAE on or before **29th February 2012**.
